



1. Who can be nominated?

- Citizens from the different state members of EROPA who are 35 years old and below and who are engaged in public service (government employee) may be nominated.

2. What is OYPA?

- The EROPA Outstanding Young Practitioner Award is a search conceptualized and organized by Eastern Regional Organization for Public Administration, Inc. (EROPA) which seeks to recognize individuals in the field of public administration and governance who are engaged in creating socio-economic development through public service.

3. Who can nominate?

- Any individual, public or private entity or organization from the different state members of EROPA can nominate.

4. What is the process for nomination?

- Fill out the Official Nomination Form and comply with the requirements stated therein. Nomination must be coursed through the institution representing the nominee's country of origin with EROPA.
